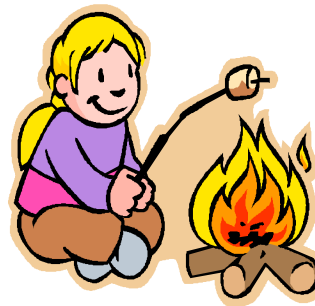
Do you like a small, homey feeling with a nurturing director and staff? Are you a very independent sort who can make your own way in a

great choice for you.

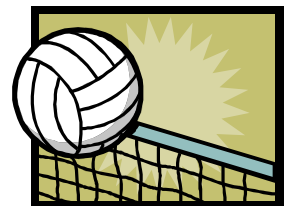
Some camps have exceptional waterfront activities such as water skiing, sailing, canoeing, swimming. Do you love the water?
